
Designating a place for performing sacrifices

بِسْمِ اللَّهِ الرَّحْمَنِ الرَّحِيمِ

Question: Is it permissible to authorise certain places in a community to be responsible for conducting (animal) sacrifices outside a specific land by taking the sacrifices of those people in that land to an outside place?

Answer: Shaykh al-Albaanee (رَحْمَةُ اللَّهِ)¹: Yes, it is permissible for the (regular) sacrifices only. As for the sacrificial offering for Hajj, then no. This is because it can only be sacrificed in Makkah. And it is not permissible to sacrifice it outside of the vicinity of the Haram. And likewise for Minaa, because the Prophet (صلى الله عليه وسلم)² informed us that "All of Minaa is a place of sacrifice."
