بِسْمِ اللَّهِ الرَّحْمَنِ الرَّحِيمِ

It is narrated from Abee Sa'eed Al-Khudree (رضي الله عنه)<sup>1</sup> that the Messenger of Allaah (صلى الله عليه وسلم)<sup>2</sup> said:

'Whoever performs Wudoo and then says:-

سُبْحَانَكَ اللَّهُمَّ وَبِحَمْدِكَ، لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا أَنْتَ، أَسْتَغْفِرُكَ وَأَتُوبُ إِلَيْكَ

'Subhanaka Allahuma wabihamdika la ilaha ila anta astaghfiruka wa atooboo ilaika'

('Far are You O Allaah from imperfection, and You have all praise, there is none worthy of worship in truth except You, I seek forgiveness from You and I repent to You),

- then this reward is written in a parchment and it is stamped with a seal and no falsehood can break it until the Day of Judgment.<sup>3</sup>
