Esaam Moosaa Haadee said, "A student of knowledge who used to study at the Institute of Sharee'ah used to work with our Shaykh (رَحِمَهُ اللهُ). During his spare time he would come to our Shaykh (رَحِمَهُ اللهُ) and transcribe for the Shaykh (رَحِمَهُ اللهُ) [whatever he wanted penned down]. So this student told me that the Shaykh (رَحِمَهُ اللهُ) once said to him, "Show me that book you have with you …" [alluding] to a book that student had with him. The Shaykh (رَحِمَهُ اللهُ) then started to look through the book. He then left the study with it and came back later returning it to the student. So when the student left our Shaykh (رَحِمَهُ اللهُ), he said, "I noticed that there was something in the book. When I had a look I saw that our Shaykh had left some money [between the pages].""²
